Greek Coordinator: Geosystems Hellas – Presenter: Betty Charalampopoulou (CEO)

Geosystems Hellas, as the host of the kick off meeting, presented the overall agenda and program of the meeting tuning the conversation in all stages.

A presentation for the work package 3 (WP3), "Data Collection and Integration", was also held, presenting the main objectives, tasks and deliverables, a presentation for the work package 6, "Integration and Evaluation" main objectives, tasks and deliverables were also presented and finally for the work package 7, "Dissemination and Exploitation" stating that the first dissemination action will be held during the 4rth Greek Surveying Engineer Symposium which will take place in Thessaloniki on the 26th of September 2014.

Israeli Coordinator: Sivan Design – Presenter: Carmi Zion (Product Manager)

Carmi Zion presented in details the first phase of the 5D MpLIS project focusing on the Israeli side. More specifically, he described the web-based software 3D GIS in the Cloud, presenting its uses and applications in the Israeli Cadastre taking into account the 3 dimensions. Furthermore, Carmi Zion presented the objectives, challenges and milestones of the project and described the next moves for the further development and amelioration of the software. Finally, Carmi Zion presented the Live Demo of the software 3D GIS in the Cloud carrying out various applications such as 3D buffering, on the fly constructions, topology connections etc.

NTUA/LOP - Presenter: Charalambos Ioannides (Professor)

Dr Charalambos Ioannides presented the role and motivation of the Laboratory of Photogrammetry of the National Technical University of Athens analyzing the main objectives of the project for the Greek side. Furthermore, a brief description of the proposed methodology was presented giving great emphasis on the research activities and on the evaluation of the process. Moreover, an extensive presentation of all the work packages was held describing the objectives and deliverables for each unique section.

Technion - Presenters: Prof. Yerach Doytsher, Dr. Sagi Dalyot

Professor Doytsher and Dr. Dalyot presented their technical background and expertise regarding the 5D MuPLIS Project.

CERTH-ITI-VCL – Presenter: Dr. Nikos Grammalidis (Senior Researcher)

Dr. Nikos Grammalidis gave a general review of the Centre for Research and Technology Hellas (CERTH) and described the role and research areas of the Information Technologies Institute (IIT). Moreover, the research interests and the related research projects to 5D MuPLIS Project were also presented, explaining how the Visual Computing Lab's expertise will contribute to the various tasks during the work packages.

NTUA/LOP - Presenters: Dr. Anastasios Doulamis, Dr. Nikolaos Doulamis

Dr. Anastasios Doulamis and Dr. Nikolaos Doulamis presented the impacts and benefits of the 5D MUPLIS Project analyzing the two different application scenarios in both Greek and Israeli case and presented a compendious description of the methodology that will be carried out.

During the kick off Meeting the logo template for the whole project, technical report and presentations was also defined after the unanimous agreement of all the partners.
